Mary Ellen Campbell Guest, 88, of Marietta, wife of the late James Edward Guest, passed away Thursday March 24, 2016 at Hope Health and Rehab of Marietta.

Born in Greenville County, she was a daughter of the late William Arthur and Mary Emma King Campbell. She retired after 41 years of teaching science at Slater-Marietta, Travelers Rest, and Northwest Middle School where she received Teacher of the Year. She was also a member and former president of the Lions Club and a longstanding member of Marietta First Baptist Church.
