I remember he would yell "Mer-Dan!", and she would yell back, "What?!", sometimes if he needed something or if he just wanted to pick on her. One day he kept calling her every time she would sit down which made her flustered after about 30 minutes (which was Papa's daily goal to pick on her and get her all flustered because he thought it was hilarious). She sat at the table for the last time with her elbow on the table and her hand to her forehead as she mumbled, "Lord what possessed me to marry this man", then she stomped into the bedroom where Papa began to laugh hysterically. "Now what do you want? Just tell me what you want and I'll get it but I ain't doing this back and forth stuff", she said with her hands on her hips. Papa would be driving with her in the passenger seat and I in the middle as a child, Mema would have her hand on her forehead looking down mumbling, "Lord please let us make it there", as she took deep breaths as if to save herself from Papa's wild driving. The many times I would aggravate her, she would yell, "Now go on somewhere! Git! Ah Emily stop!". Oh my goodness, the times Mema would visit Gail Roach, her hairdresser, she would return home and Papa would say, "Dal Mer-Dan I thought she was going to fix it not make it worse!", he would look at me with a wink after he slapped my arm with a big grin on his face knowing what her reaction would be. She was a very loving woman (who gave the best hugs) that loved with all of her heart and would do anything for anyone. She was a fiery, tough, spunky, classy lady that ALWAYS had to have matching clothes/jewelry even if she were to be sitting in her house doing nothing. She loved her some Hamrick's, the orange circus peanuts, nutter butter cookies, Coca-Cola with peanuts, and spending time with her family. She was a passionate woman that loved God and her family and she didn't put up with any junk. She didn't mind setting people straight if needed. She was very intelligent and had a heart of gold; someone who could make anyone smile or laugh and would light up the room with her sweet presence, smile, laugh, and her many facial expressions. I'm very grateful, thankful, and appreciative to have Mary Dan Kay as my Mema and thank you for being there for me for all those years. May we meet again sweet pea.
