



## Minnie "Betty" Henson Daves

April 23, 1927 - December 3, 2020

Minnie Elizabeth "Betty" Henson Daves, 93, widow of Guy "Happy" Daves, resident of 207 Love Drive, Travelers Rest, South Carolina, died on Thursday, December 3, 2020.
