Myrtle Elizabeth (Morrison) McGriff, 98, went to be with the Lord on Tuesday, July 14, 2015 at her daughter's home in Rock Hill, SC.

Born in Greenville County, she was the daughter of the late Quay Anderson and Nancy Loretta Jones Morrison. She retired from the United States Post Office in Travelers Rest and was a member of the Gold Star Wives Association. She was a member of Travelers Rest United Methodist Church and attended Cornerstone United Methodist Church in Rock Hill.
