Rick was always a great teacher and helped Nancy be able to play the bass at church. Her joy always showed on her face with each note she would strum.

She was a loyal member of Jones Hill Church of God where she taught the Ladies Class for many years; she sang in the choir then began to play her bass guitar. She would decorate the sanctuary and fellowship hall each year for Christmas, and she was head of the Benevolence Committee for many years.
