Patrick Smith, 77, passed away Monday, February 5, 2018.

Born in Cleveland, OH, he was the son of the late Fred G and Margaret Harlan Smith. Pat was an owner of State Farm Insurance Company for over forty years in Miami. Pat recorded a record at The Grand Ole Opry and graduated from The University of Georgia on a full ride football and baseball scholarship. Pat coached the inner city kids at the boys club during 1966 to mid-1970's and was an Elder at Granada Presbyterian Church in Coral Gables.
