Philip Leland (Phil) Edge, 75, of Travelers Rest, passed away on Tuesday, November 15, 2022, at Palmetto Patriots Home in Gaffney, SC.

Born in Spartanburg, SC, he was a son of the late Leland Thomas and Helen Virginia Dixon Edge. Mr. Edge was a Vietnam era U.S. Navy Veteran. It was one of his greatest honors to serve his country. He was a beloved Principal in the Greenville County School System for 36 years and he was a member of Marietta First Baptist Church.

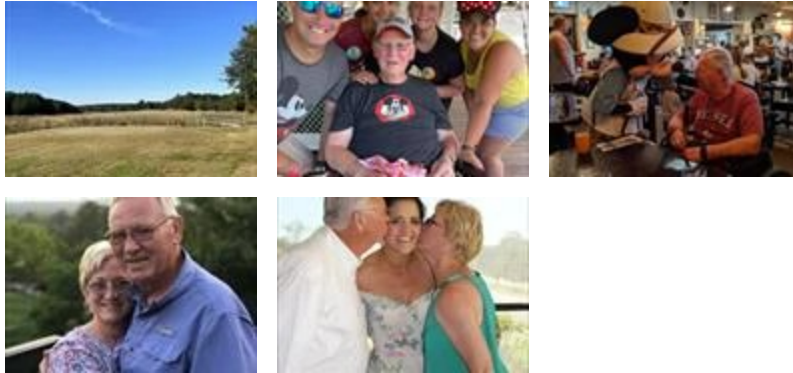
