Rev. Preston C. Blackstock, 87, went home to be with the Lord on Saturday, November 3, 2007, at Westside Living Center.

Born in Anderson, SC, he was the son of the late Barney N. and Harriett Roberts Blackstock. Rev. Blackstock was an Army veteran of WWII; graduate of Holmes Theological Seminary; founder of Metropolitan Cleaners in Greenville and a member of Tremont Church of God.

Surviving are his wife of 66 years, Margaret Padgett Blackstock of the home; daughter: Becky Blackstock Bean and husband Jim of Germantown, TN; 2 sons: Earl Blackstock and wife Dale of Taylors and Tommy Blackstock and wife Jean of Greenville; daughter-in-law, Joyce Blackstock of Greenville; 3 step-brothers: Paul, Silas and John Blackstock; 10 grandchildren, 10 great-grandchildren and 3 great-great grandchildren.
