Richard Von Hallman, 84, of Berea, passed away on Thursday, July 18, 2024. Born in Gilbert, SC, he was a son of the late Richard McRee and Beatrice Vonie Whittle Hallman. Richard served in the US Air Force National Guard during the Berlin Crisis and retired from Union Carbide. He was a member of Berea First Baptist Church since 1970, where he served as a Deacon for many years and was very active with Disciples in Action.
