Robert Earl Tripp, 95, of Marietta, husband of the late Kirby Lee Starkey Tripp, went to be with his Lord and Savior, Sunday, July 30, 2017.

Born in Ware Shoals, he was a son of the late Noah and Ethel Reid Tripp. Mr. Tripp served in the U.S. Army in WWII as a gunner on a half-track, under George Patton 3rd Army, during Normandy, Northern France, Rhineland, Ardennes, and Central Europe. He was one of the few left from The Greatest Generation and was also of the Baptist Faith.
