Roy David "Billy" Brookshire, 86, of Travelers Rest, passed away on Saturday, March 11, 2017.

Born in Greenville County, he was a son of the late Franklin David Brookshire and the late Annie Lee Tereba. 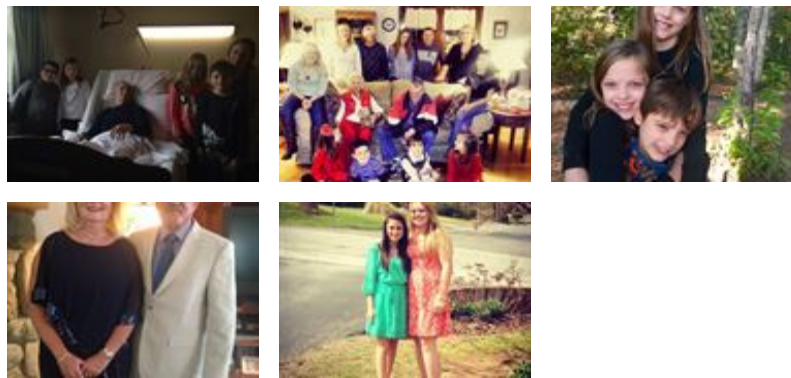

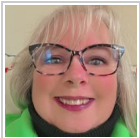
