Salvatore Anthony Rossano, Sr., 85, formerly of Pompano Beach, FL and Smallwood, NY, passed away on Saturday, January 26, 2013 at McCall Hospice House in Simpsonville, SC.

Born in New York City on January 12, 1928, he was a son of the late Giovanni and Fortunata Rossano. Mr. Rossano was a US Army Veteran of WWII; a retired Construction Operating Engineer, (International Union of Operating Engineers) for over twenty five years and assisted in the construction of the original World Trade Center. 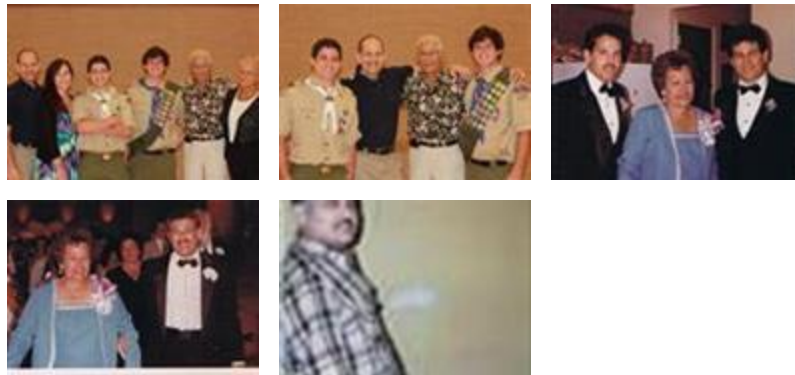
