Thure Lundgren, 92, loving husband and father, passed away on Friday, February 24, 2012.

Born in Chicago, IL, he was the son of the late Thure, Sr. and Thora Berg Lundgren. He was a US Army Veteran of WWII, honorably discharged at the rank of First Lieutenant and was of the Protestant faith. An avid reader, Thure attended Northwestern University in Chicago and had a lengthy career with the original Chicago Display Company, now Sunoco, serving as company Comptroller, retiring at 86 years of age.

He is survived by his wife of 71 years, Jane Janac Lundgren; daughters: Deborah (Al) Evans of the United Kingdom, Diane (Tony) Bernat of Greenville and Niece Lundgren of Saluda, NC; son: Douglas (Donna) Lundgren of Houston, TX; sister: Clare (Jack) Enright of Bloomington, IN; 4 grandchildren and 5 great-grandchildren.
