Tina was born on January 26, 1971 at DePaul Hospital in Norfolk Virginia. She was 39 years old. After graduating from high school she began her family life and while raising five children she obtained a Bachelors of Science Degree in Nursing. Her former employer was Greenville Hospital System. She was an Independent Baptist who loved the Lord and was a member of Faith Baptist Church in Taylors SC. Tina was most happy spending time traveling with her husband and children. 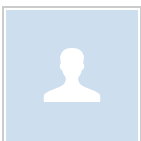
