



## Vernon Tate Armstrong

June 9, 1941 - May 6, 2021

Vernon Tate Armstrong, 79, of Travelers Rest, passed away on Thursday, May 6, 2021 at his home.

Born in Greenville County, SC he was a son of the late Vanoy Vernon and Mantha Eudora Tate Armstrong. Mr. Armstrong was retired from Western Auto in Travelers Rest. At the age of 14, he joined Ebenezer Baptist Church where he served as a Deacon, Sunday School Teacher, RA Director, and a youth leader. 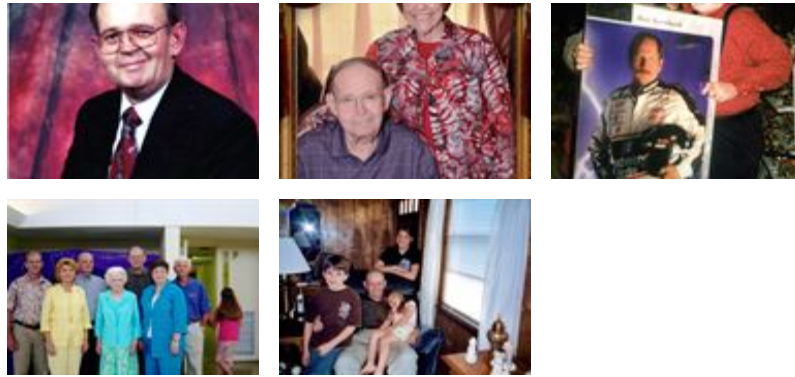
