February 13, 1945 - December 28, 2013

Rev. William Donald (Don) Waters, 68, of Cleveland, went to be with his Lord and Savior Jesus Christ on Saturday, December 28, 2013 at his home. Rev. Waters was a US Army 11th ACR veteran of Vietnam and Pastor of Carsons Creek Baptist Church in Brevard, NC for the past 27 years.

Surviving is his wife of 50 years, Joan Hardin Waters; a son Byron Todd Waters; a brother, Kenneth Waters and wife Martha; three sisters, Jean Waldrop, Gail Hipp and Ida Boswell and husband Maurice.

He was predeceased by his parents, William Hughey and Marie Crain Waters. Funeral services will be held at 1 o'clock Tuesday afternoon at Carsons Creek Baptist Church, in Brevard, NC , with burial to follow in the Hardin Family Cemetery, Cleveland, SC.
