Walter Franklin Stokes, 88, entered the presence of God on Sunday, November 5th, 2023, at his home surrounded by his loving family.

Born in Greer, SC, he was the son of the late Oscar Boyd Stokes and Eunice Lynn Stokes. Walter served in the United States Air Force and was employed by Stevens Aviation before becoming self-employed. He, along with his late wife, Jean, founded Faith Ministries and for 35 years traveled extensively, including prisons, sharing the Good News of Jesus Christ and was a member of Praise Cathedral Church of God.

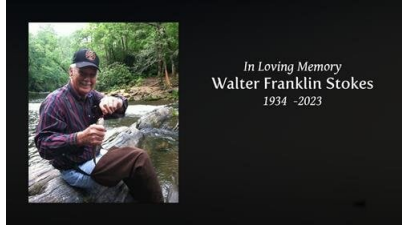
