William Clyde "Bill" Burgess, husband of Elaine McAlister Burgess of the Tigerville Community, died July 6, 2021.

Born in Greenville County, he was the son of the late William Wriley and Corinna Moize Burgess. Bill was educated in Parker District Schools and attended several schools while serving on active duty with the United States Army. He retired from the Army after more than twenty years active duty, having served two Tours in the Republic of Vietnam with the First Cavalry Division, and having attained the rank of Chief Warrant Officer. He received several awards during his active duty.

A member of First Baptist Church, Travelers Rest, he had served as Deacon Chairman, Sunday School Teacher and Director, church clerk, and church treasurer.

Bill was a life member and Past Master of Sam Poe Lodge #284, AFM, a life member of Cooper Lodge #282, AFM, a life member and Past Patron of Travelers Rest Chapter #205 and was currently a life member of Greer Chapter #151 and Past Grand Patron of the Grand Chapter of South Carolina, Order of the Eastern Star. In addition to his parents, Bill was predeceased by a brother-in-law, Maurice Mull; father-in-law, Earl McAlister and sister-in-law, Wanda McAlister DuBard.
