

William Jeffrey "Jeff" Greene

November 15, 1941 - January 23, 2024

William Jeffrey "Jeff" Greene, age 82, of Greenville, passed away on Tuesday, January 23rd, 2024, at his home with his loving family by his side.

Born in Greer, SC, Jeff was the son of the late William Leaster Greene and Sammie Lee Phillips Greene. He was a 1960 graduate of Greer High School and went on to earn his 4-year bachelor's degree from Furman University. Jeff joined the United States Navy where he served as a Torpedoman aboard the Submarine USS Harder SS 568 during the Vietnam Era. He made some lifelong friends during his time in service, and they stayed in contact with each other throughout the years maintaining that close brotherhood bond. After graduating from Furman, he worked as a Potter and was the owner of The Potters House. He also studied alongside Master Potter Charles Counts of Rising Fawn, GA. and was mentored by local Master Potter Don Lewis. He loved his family dearly and faithfully attended Trinity Lutheran Church in Greenville when his health allowed him to go.

He is survived by his wife of 62 years Donna Foxworth Greene of Greenville, One son, Marcus Lee (Lisa) Greene of Travelers Rest; Grandchildren Alex Greene, Elizabeth (Angel) Greene-Ferreira of Travelers Rest, SC; One brother, Scott (Carla) Greene of Greer, SC; Daughter in law, Bridgette Prat & step granddaughter Lulu Prat of Brooklyn, NY.

In addition to his parents, Jeff was preceded in death by one son, William Jeffrey Greene Jr.

A Celebration of Life service at Trinity Lutheran Church in Greenville will be held Wednesday, January 31, 2024 at 12:00 with a visitation reception of friends to immediately follow the service. 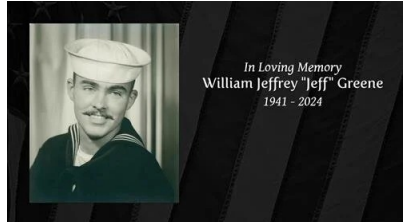
